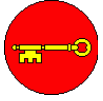

General Meeting Minutes

4 Sept. 2019

In Attendance: Meadhbh, James, Jois, Toussaint, Calamus, Valamar

Nikolaus: *Music guild* : The Music Guild will be performing at Dance Seminar, will not be performing at Boar's Head or Twelfth Night;

WW Review: Mostly positive reviews about the site and the event;

Rapier: have between 6-12 rapier fighters each Wednesday, and another 6 fighters on Sundays.

Unfortunately, a rapier injury did occur recently, and it was reported. injury. All Marshal reports have been filed, including Herald's reports;

Asa: Nothing to report on the Exchequer front

James: Archery continues to have high levels of participation, with a second sign-in sheet needed to accommodate all the archers. Donations have been coming in regularly.

Jois: Still seeking a volunteer to run a Harvest Moot and Yule Moot; seeking largess for Her Majesty. There is a link for desired items on the Jara page, as well as Her Majesty's webpage: Her Majesty would also love to have volunteers available for retainers. Fuel cards are always helpful. Finally, we really need students from the UW-Madison. If you are a student, or if you know a student, please reach out to Their Excellencies.

Arwa: 745 gentles at WW: 113 minors; WW came in at \$4100 less this year, with a profit of at least \$8000. Website hosting for the event will be moved; We will be using revenue from the event to pay \$2000 to each Barony to zero out the money loaned to the event in 2014. Will also donate \$632 to the Kingdom to honor the 632 gentles who attended the event. We will be sending the city of Tomah a deposit to lock in the site for next year. News on the infrastructure front, the WW Showers need to be rebuilt. Ed estimates about \$1800 to fix. We also have quotes needed for site improvements for items such as banners water and first aid stations and poles; 20 portable radios and batteries for said radios ; spraying for bugs prior to the event; mist tent; sidewalk chalk; chalk paint; firepits; increased number of handicapped-accessible portajohns; The storage facility that we have used for event materials has been bought by new owners, however, WW Storage Unit has been paid through July of 2020. The new owners will be releasing invoices for the year one week prior to the rent being due, so reminders will be made to make sure that we contact owners prior to July.

Adelwald A&S: A&S continues, Griffin Needle is next month;

Rob the Stout: Armored combat continues; Marshal reports have been filed; 6-10 fighters each session; stock pavilion is available save for the first week of December 4th and December 7th due to Tree Sale.
