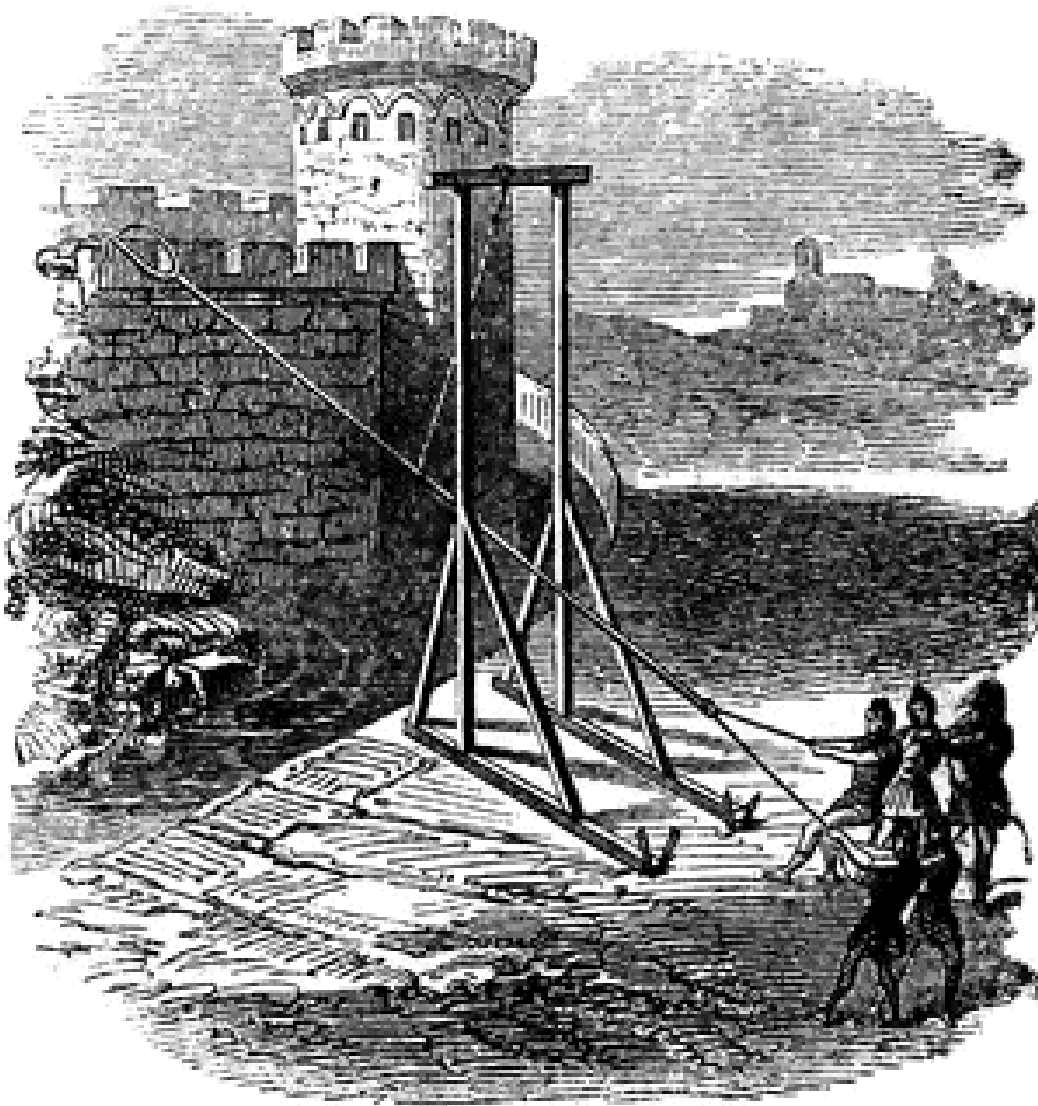

Gewn want to do a baronial garb closet clean out.

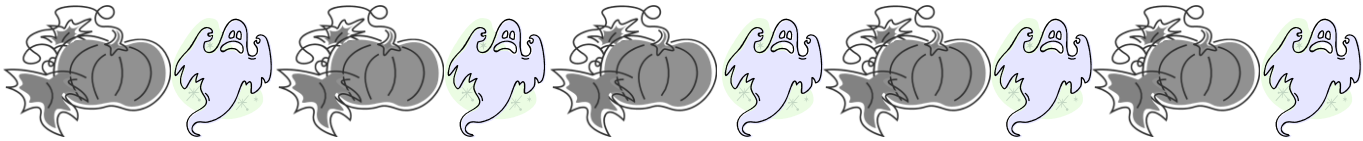
Ryes sent out emails to specific people to host crown or coronation since has of now there are no bids. It was decided that if there was no bids by the next general meeting the barony may host it again.

EUROPEAN DANCE PRACTICE

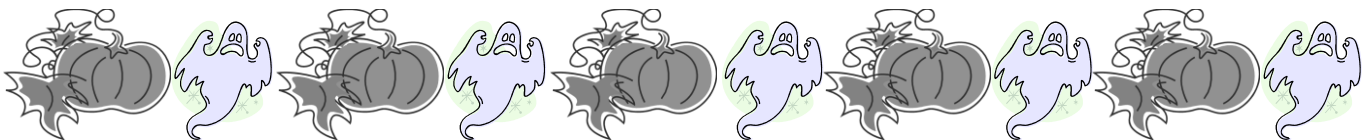

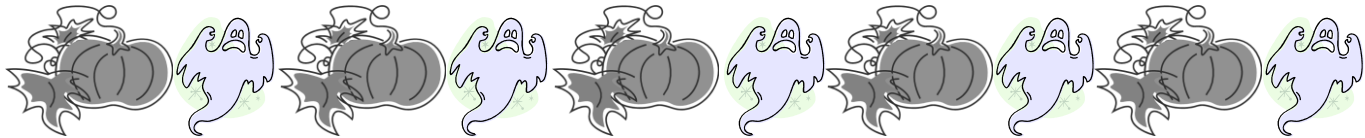


COME ONE COME ALL we will be having our BARONIAL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENTS...

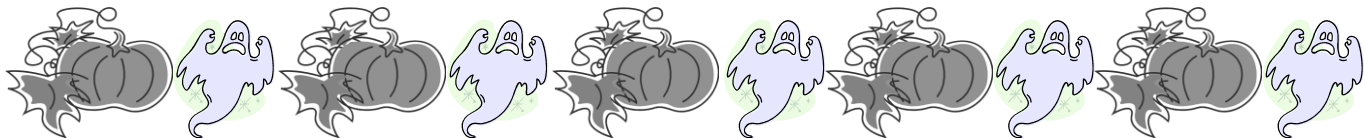
