LETTERS FROM his excellency

Greetings unto the Barony on this cold winter evening.

Two years ago I had the honor of being chosen as Baron for Jararvellir. It is the tradition of Jararvellir that the term of its Baronage is three years. After this time, the standing Baronage may choose to step down, or elect to stay on (pending Their Majesty's approval).

I intend to step down as Baron at the end of my term. As most of you know, my wife is not active in the SCA. Two years ago she agreed to me becoming Baron, knowing that the term is three years. It is not fair of me to ask her to accept me being Baron for a second term.
