General discussion – the Stock Pavilion fund is chronically overdrafted, despite the Stock Pavilion only costing \$10 per use. Some suggestions for increasing awareness and stimulating donations were made.

Marion (on behalf of Fred) – Fred is putting together a bid for Baronial May Day Moot – Saturday, May 6, 2017 at Edgewood College.

Niklaus (Music Guild) – Music Guild is on hiatus for the foreseeable future because attendance has been low to nonexistent.

AEsa (Exchequer deputy) – took Stock Pavilion money.

Robert (Baron) – Reporting for Aniera – Tacky Garb Ball: Tacky Garb Ball was a success. Approximately 100 paid attendees, plus comps. The event made about \$500 and people are already asking about next year. Fighter Symposium: teachers are still needed, especially for kids and rapier. Some staff positions are also still available. Arwa – Bardic – She will be taking over Bardic nights from Jose, initially to meet monthly. Bardic Madness – the event will be held April 1, planning is going well.

Toussaint (Seneschal) – WW is working on finalizing the contract and budget. Seneschal is looking for a successor. There are a number of things in the Baronial Storage locker that are never used. There is an event site owned by SCAadjacent people opening soon and they are looking for second-hand items. Some of the things in the storage locker will be evaluated for potential resale, including things like the boxes of glasses that had been purchased for Knowne World Cooks and Bards. There was general support for this plan. General discussion about the need for WW to get on the calendar ASAP and to post prices as soon as they are available, so people can plan. The prices will likely need to increase, since we lost money last year
